**New business:**

- A) Open Space recommendation of Hall Property Mark and Dennis present the commission with information regarding the Ellana Hall property. **Director's Report:**

- A) Summer program – The summer program will have a Game show theme this summer, every Monday there will be a new team game show for all participants to play. We will be going to quite a few field trips this summer, water wiz, plays, inflatable park, pawsox, tide flats and many more. Each participant will get a orange t-shirt with a sign up, with the recreation logo on the front, for safety. All children will be swim tested, and any child not deemed a swimmer will have to wear a coast guard approved life jacket.
- B) VMCC/East end playgrounds –VMCC playground received two tractor trailer loads of wood safety fibers. Volunteers and recreation staff were gathered to spread them around the playground, it took a full day but the playground looks sharp, and is above the safety grade line on all the posts. At the east end playground we have installed a new small piece of playground equipment. The new piece is three plastic circles hung from aluminum posts that the children have to climb through.
- C) East end basketball court project: The project will be placed out to bid this summer, there has been a delay in the project due to personnel changes in the DPW. Now Deputy Director and the

recreation director are working together to finish the invitation to bid for the project.

**Assistant Director's Report:**

A) End of afterschool – the last day of the Afterschool program will be June 26<sup>th</sup>, even though there is school on June 27<sup>th</sup>. Since June 27<sup>th</sup> is a half day, and is the beginning of the Portuguese festival, the department can not do afterschool care on the 27<sup>th</sup>. The program has been well attended all year, averaging between 25 to 30 children per day.

B) Tball update- Angel is coaching tball, and have been practicing for four weeks, they will have a game vs Wellfleet at Motta field on June 18<sup>th</sup>.
