## 2015 Annual Spring Traffic Hearing Results

The Provincetown Board of Selectmen held a public hearing on **Tuesday, March 10, 2015, at 5:00 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Room, Town Hall 260 Commercial St. Provincetown, Massachusetts 02657 and then and there approved/denied/withdrew the following item proposals.

### Citizen Proposals

1. Denied the actual proposal by Irv Morgan to replace the sign adjacent to Seashore Point on Alden Street to read "Senior Living" in lieu of the existing sign which reads "Nursing Home Ahead"; **but did approve removing the sign entirely.**
2. Denied the actual proposal by Robin Higgins to move the crosswalk at Alden and Bradford Streets several feet to the east of its current location, lining up with the parking lot kiosk on the north and the fire hydrant in front of 133 Bradford Street on the south; **but did approve to move the parking kiosk that is on the east side over to the equivalent parking space on the west side closer to the crosswalk.**
3. Proposal by John McDonagh, Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum **was withdrawn by proponent.**
4. **No action was taken on** proposal by Michael Glasfeld, Mayflower Trolley LLC.
