


Provincetown Beautification Committee



MINUTES

Thursday, April 14, 2011, 5:30pm Caucus Hall, Town Hall.

Present: Todd Westrick, Mary Ann Powers, Barbara Rushmore, Bobby Cole, Ross Sormani and David Gardner, Assistant Town Manager.

Not Present: Paul Hall, Sheila LaMontagne and Ghee Patrick on excused absence.

Mary Ann Powers moved to accept the Minutes of 4-7-11. Todd Westrick seconded. So all voted.

Financial: \$30.79 has been spent from Budget, leaving \$3,950.70 in the Budget.

The Tree Pruning has been postponed to Wednesday, 4-20-11.

Islands: Ray Duarte, Highway Dept., and Tony Lemne, Building and Grounds, feel that all 5 islands will be prepared for planting by the end of May. Todd Westrick will prepare the preliminary order for these islands from Sylvan Nursery. Barbara Rushmore to order trees for Trees for Town, to be shipped together. There will be 3 trees for Maushope. Brian Carlson is to be consulted to give his OK on any trees near 100 feet from the beach, concerning a possible tree at Julie Heller's on the beach at Gosnold.

Grace Hall Parking Lot Cleanup: An amended posting for this Sunday, April 17th, has been posted. 3-5 more cleanups may be needed. We will not work on Easter Sunday.

Next March we should plan for Earth Day.

Mulching at the Grace Hall Parking Lot will be after the weeds are all removed. Todd Westrick hopes by May 22nd. Mary Ann Powers moved to accept the Grace Hall Reclamation Plan. Tedd Westrick seconded. So all voted.

Todd Westrick will contact Provincetown Magazine for cleanup publicity.

At Bradford and Ryder Streets, a stop sign is to be placed on the paved street and the boxed, Black Pines from the parking lot are to be used there. Moved by Barbara Rushmore. Seconded by Todd Westrick. All so voted.

Discussion with Bobby Joe Cole focused on work on Lopes Square weeding and the toilet area, and then the Grace Hall Parking Lot.

Mary Ann Powers moved that a bilge pump and 150 feet of heavy duty, high quality hose be ordered by Tony Lemne up to \$200 and to be charged to the Beautification budget. Todd Westrick seconded. So all voted.

Next meeting will be Thursday, April 28th at 5:30 pm. Meeting adjourned.
