MINUTES

Thursday, May 12, 2011, 5:30pm Building Inspector's Conf. Rm., Town Hall.

Present: Todd Westrick, Mary Ann Powers, Ghee Patrick, Barbara Rushmore, Ross Sormani, David Polaneo, David McChesney and David Gardner, Assistant Town Manager.

Not Present: Sheila La Montagne on excused absence.

Ross Sormani moved that the Minutes of April 26 be approved. Todd Westrick seconded. So all voted.

Financial Report:

Todd Westrick moved that \$24.61 spent on refreshments for the Cleanup of 4-17-11 be reimbursed to him from the Budget. Barbara Rushmore seconded. So all voted.

Ross Sormani moved that \$24.61 spent on refreshments at the Cleanup of May 1st be reimbursed to him. Barbara Rushmore seconded. So all voted.

Mary Ann Powers moved that Forest Keepers be paid \$2300. from the Budget for the trimming of 6 Town trees. Barbara Rushmore seconded. So all voted, leaving approx. \$1600. in the 2011 Budget.

The Beautification Gift Fund is at \$22,369.98. The VSB Waterfront Park Gift Fund is at \$412.00.

Old Business:

Todd Westrick feels the Grace Hall Cleanups, Sunday, 10am, May 15th plus Thursday, May 19th and Thursday, May 26th will finish the Grace Hall Cleanup. Estimates on mulch showed GFM at \$4700. and Paul Daniels at \$2800. with MacNamara's estimate still to come in. Ross Sormani moved that we spend up to \$3200. for mulch. Mary Ann Powers seconded. So all voted.

On Tuesday, May 17th the plant materials for the 6 islands will arrive at 7am and will be planted shortly thereafter with assistance from Buildings and Grounds.

Todd Westrick moved that the Waterfront Memorial Park be mowed and maintained by Bobbie Jo Cole of Building and Grounds. Barbara Rushmore seconded. All so voted. The plans will be made in the fall for the Waterfront Memorial Park.

Tree Law, distributed by Todd Westrick, was given to members and will be discussed later.

Barbara Rushmore suggested the Beautification Committee be involved in the re-doing of Commercial Street. The Committee made no decision.
