

# Provincetown Beautification Committee



## MINUTES

Thursday, November 1, 2011, 5:00pm Caucus Rm., Town Hall.

The minutes of the October 5<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.

The planting of a tree on Standish Street, near Commercial Street, was discussed. Barbara Rushmore reported that the Water Department checked that the site does not interfere with the underground water and sewer pipes and the Commercial Street paving project does not extend up Standish Street. David Gardner, Assistant Town Manager, said he would like street grates around trees and information was gathered. The cost is very high. No action was taken.

Lopes Square benches were discussed. The 8-foot bench facing the garbage cans should be removed. Abutters were contacted and Candice Collins-Boden of the Chamber of Commerce suggested 4 benches be installed on the long sides of the 10 by 20 ft. beds for the two locust trees. No action was taken.

The next meeting date in December was set. (This December meeting was later cancelled.)
