Provincetown Charter Revision

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 43B, Section 9, the **Provincetown Charter Commission** will hold a **Public Hearing on Thursday, June 16, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Room, Provincetown Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA 02657 to begin the process to review and revise the Provincetown Charter. The purposes of the Public Hearing are: (1) to present an overview of the purpose of the Commission; (2) to present the process and proposed timeline; and (3) to hear comments from the Public on ideas for proposed changes to the Charter.

Copies of the Charter are available on the Town's website and in the Office of the Town Clerk.

Members of the public are encouraged to submit their comments in writing to the Town Clerk or to the Charter Commission at 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown MA 02657, by noon on Tuesday, June 14, 2016, or in person (either orally or in writing) at the hearing.
