Review/amend/approve minutes of May 26, 2016: Moved by V. Seltsam to approve minutes as presented, 2nd E. Cozzi, Vote: 4 0 0

Public Statements :

- 1 William Docker, Chair of the Beautification Committee. The Committee has met with Harbormaster R. McKinsey to express an interest in having a voice in any proposals regarding the future of 'harbor walks, memorial areas, park spaces, street scapes' that may unite the wharf/marina and Town Hall/Bas Relief areas.
- 2 Gary Reinhardt spoke to the Committee of his concerns regarding the new 'trot line' installed at the West End Boat Ramp. He views it as a hazard to navigation for swimmers, paddle boarders, small boaters. Under Chap. 91 people walk the beach and at night they may not see the line.
- 3 Elise Cozzi wondered why there are no kayak racks east of Flyers Boatyard as there are multiple kayaks up on dune areas. She also expressed concern regarding the 'trot line' at the West End Boat Ramp

Harbormaster Report :

- 1 Harbormaster McKinsey showed the Committee the proposed new signs that will be used on the kayak racks. Moved by L. Ludwig to approve the new kayak rack signage and its placement on the racks, 2nd E. Cozzi, Vote: 5 0 0
- 2 Committee Chair Santos requested that the kayak racks at Ryder St. and Gosnold St. be repositioned to be closer to the water. Moved by V. Seltsam that the racks be so repositioned, 2nd L. Ludwig, Vote: 5 0 0
- 3 Committee member V. Seltsam has placed the mooring rings in the seawall at the West End Boat Ramp

New Business: Municipal Comment on Chapter 91 for the Provincetown Marina
Harbormaster R. McKinsey presented the Committee with a template letter with the
Committee's response for the Chapter 91 license.

Moved by L. Ludwig to accept the template letter as proposed with the following
bullets as discussed:

- safe public access be provided
- the proposed walkway be tied into the water front park
- the legal ownership to the area(s) the walkway may cross be insured
- insure that it is a transient public marina
- amenities along the walkway be provided
