OLD BUSINESS Review completed Harbor Brochure Sheila La Montagne reported the text was corrected, charts and maps updated, and a mock up will be ready at the end of the month for review per Jon Gilmore. Sheila will be out of town but recommended that Richard Olson review final proof.

Chapter 91 Report One new license was issued. Rex McKinsey offered to file a copy for the committee. Discussion centered on an Amed Corp volunteer to work with John Gilmore to input licenses into a central data base. We hope the town will keep a file on each property settled with the conditions agreed upon with the State. Sheila LaMontagne offered to help with the application and recommended August as the time to apply for a person for this position. Bevedy suggested we wait for Jon Gilmore to decide if he wants the volunteer, hrs. etc. and Rex suggested the information compiled be made available on the Town Website.

Mel Cote volunteered to call Keith Bergman for a meeting with CZM, Bob O'Leary's office, and the Amnesty Steering Committee to discuss the Amnesty Program Request in Keith's memo of May 27, 2003

NEW BUSINESS: Jet Ski Regs and enforcement- Discussion as to resolution of previous problems, unable to determine the outcome of the suit by jet ski business owner. The marker buoys have been set.

Al Davis suggested that an Amed Corp volunteer research "Right of Ways". Al could mark the properties and give street addresses. The position would also involve research about who is paying the property tax. Whoever is paying the tax could lease the "right of way" to the town, the town could accept liability, and this would increase access to harbor in areas especially in the east end of town.
