

**AIRPORT COMMISSION**

**WORK SESSION:**

- A) Discussion and information gathering regarding transportation in and out of Provincetown, and how the Airport can be engaged in these efforts. Votes may be taken.

The Commission discussed connectivity between the airport and town. There was discussion regarding busses, taxi service, trolley, and Regional Transit Authority. Steve suggested the possibility of an RFP for transportation to service the airport.

Rob Compton discussed Cape Air and activities in town including possibility for a discount rate for non-profits. Michelle Haynes stated that Cape Air continues to support non-profits, and there is no need to help filling seats on Cape Air as most planes as full. Steve Katsurinis questioned later flights arriving from Boston to Provincetown. Jim Keefe discussed general aviation stating that an active airport will generate more traffic.

The Committee discussed having food available at the Airport. Michelle Haynes questioned having a food truck. Also discussed was possibly speaking to Farland as they provide food in the National Seashore and having the town subsidize.

**Rob Compton will lead a sub group which will include John Reed and Jim Keefe to gather information on food and transportation to and from Provincetown and the Airport. Butch Lisenby stated the need to expand past Provincetown. Jim Keefe made a motion to meet with Cape Cod National Seashore Superintendent which was seconded by Rob Compton and passed 4-0-0.**

**B) Other matters that may legally come before the commission not known at the time of posting. Votes may be taken.**

**Bill Richardson suggested putting ads in trade magazines (i.e. Atlantic Flyer) to advertise opportunities that are unique to Provincetown which might help with general aviation.**

**Steve Katsurinis closed the meeting at 2:45 p.m. which passed 4-0-0**
