

There was a meeting of the Open Space Committee on Monday, July 9, 2018, at 5:00 PM, in the Judge Welsh Meeting Room in Provincetown Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA 02657

Members present: Susan Avellar, Susan Cook, Robin Evans, and Dennis Minsky

Also present: Tim Famulare, Town Environmental Planner and Conservation Agent, and Jeffrey Ribeiro, Town Planner

The entire agenda of the meeting was the presentation to the public, including those living within the Environmental Justice area, the committee's plan for the acquisition of the Hall Parking Lot and the subsequent creation of a waterfront park to allow access to the beach, provide amenities for the public for rest and recreation, and promote the historical aspects of Provincetown's fishing legacy and working waterfront.

Famulare provided details about the State PARC grant that the Town is pursuing.

Rebeiro mentioned that this project is consistent with the Town's Open Space and Recreation Plan and the Town's Harbor Plan.

Avellar discussed Chapter 91 issues, sea level rise and coastal inundation, and the various amenities that could be included in the park.
