Discussion

Water & Sewer Board request for sewer connection criteria

Austin Knight represented the Water & Sewer Board. He stated that board has been meeting with BOS in meetings facilitated by John Goodrich to develop criteria for the next phase of sewer connection, which will be presented to Fall Town Meeting. The BoH decided to add the following clause: Property owners have the right to request waiver of sewer connection on a case by case basis.

After much discussion the following motion was presented:

Motion: To add to BoH regulations, Part XIII Dog Restraint, Article 2, Section 1:

For public health and sanitary purposes the Board of Health requires all Town of Provincetown owned public playgrounds, including schools, and playing fields to be declared dog free zones. However, dogs will be permitted on leash, on the perimeter of field during games or practices and in compliance with all other Dog by laws.
