Minutes

I. Meeting Called to Order at 5:00pm

Members present: David Flattery, chair, Susan Avellar, Laura Ludwig; excused – John Santos, Elise Cozzi, Bryan Legare. Rex McKinsey, Harbormaster.

II. Review/amend/approve minutes Laura moved to approve the minutes of 3/6/19. Susan 2nded and all were in favor.

III. Public Statements n/a

IV. Harbormaster Report Rex provided a report submitted to the Pier Corp on 3/12 to update the committee. He also finalized the warrant articles pertaining to the pier (see New Business). This year's request for \$200,000 for pier maintenance is the third of five annual requests. The shoreline protection article will partially fund the design and permitting of Gosnold Street restoration, and provide local match for other fundraising efforts.

Rex updated us on the attenuator project. Roles have been determined, designated and filled by the engineering firm and Harbormaster staff.

V. Old Business: Signs and Landings. We reviewed the landing/sign inventory that Laura and Elise provided on 2/22. Signage needs to be upgraded in four categories: Town Landings, Commercial St to the beach (Ch. 91 Rights of Way), public access points and blue Beachwalk signs. Discussed a slight revision in the way points of access are identified. Laura spoke to a professional designer who is willing to work with us.

VI. New Business: Discussed ATM articles -- Susan moved to recommend to the BOS that the Harbor Committee supports both Article 13C for pier maintenance and Article 13L for shoreline protection, as printed in the warrant. David seconded and all were in favor.

David suggested meeting in the summer, maybe once or twice to follow through with some of our projects.

We are considering re-installing the vertical stones that mark the groynes. David will get an estimate from a heavy equipment outfit. The town does not own the equipment necessary to operate on the flats at low tide.

VII. Laura moved to adjourn, Susan seconded and all were in favor; meeting adjourned at 5:55pm.
