Case #2003-020 Gary Palochko, 14 Court Street, [Map/Parcel 07-2-149; MHC #None; Historic Name: Central chimney ½ house; Date: 1800-1830; Style: Timber frame; Victorian alteration] *Previously reviewed - designer to submit revised plans for final approval.*
