Tracey – Dottie told her she was going to resign.

Ongoing Business:

Ramps – Chamber of Commerce – not complete – no railing on wood ramp, entrance to Chamber office not wheelchair accessible, stone ramp uneven, no access to side ramp due to uneven landing at bottom of ramp. Items are on order and repairs to side ramp to be reviewed.

Handicap parking spaces behind Town Hall – per Jeff Dougan, MA ADA, spaces can be restricted to business only when Town Hall is open.

Funicular – applying for permits. Cost of new Accessible parking and car ramp will be included in costs for this year with cost of funicular which may trigger other ADA compliance.

Liz's – new bell on side of building which can be used to alert staff to need for portable ramp. Sign not easily seen and there should be a second sign in front window.

Linda – would like to have non-smoking benches by Town Hall and better access to West End beach with railing on stairs.

Rowen – suggested that we have small wallet cards defining law about Service Animals. Will look into design of card.

New Business:

Tim Famulare – asking for assistance to make new park on Commercial St. accessible. Asking for Mobi mats, accessible seating, etc. Referred to Accessible Provincetown due to cost of project.

Parking will be replacing exit booth and replacing it with an ADA compliant booth. This may require moving shed that contains Mobi chairs. Need to find space accessible to Chamber.
