PARKING PERMIT FEES

The Provincetown Select Board will hold a public hearing on **Monday, February 10, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Room, Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA 02657 to consider proposed changes to the Parking and Traffic Regulations as it applies to Parking Permit Fees.

Article 1 Rates and Rules
