Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Provincetown **Charter Compliance Commission** will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. For this meeting, members of the public who wish to watch/listen and participate in the meeting may do so in the following manner:

1. To listen and participate in this meeting, dial **(833) 579-7589**. When prompted, enter the following Conference ID number: **597 575 680#**. When prompted, state your name, then press #.
 - Keep your phone muted at all times when not talking
 - Do not use speakerphone
 - Do not use Bluetooth devices
 - Mute all background noises
 - Mute PTV on the television or computer and use only the phone audio
 - Please do not speak until the chair or the meeting moderator asks for public comments or questions.

No in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. In the event that we are unable to do so, despite best efforts, we will post on the Provincetown website an audio or video recording or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting.

In accordance with §2-3-g-4 of the Provincetown Charter, the Provincetown Charter Compliance Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Friday, March 27, 2020, at 11:00 a.m. in the Caucus Hall, Provincetown Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, to solicit comments from the public and to vote in favor or opposed to articles.
