The Provincetown Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing at 6:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, May 19, 2020**, in Provincetown, MA, to consider the following requests:

CON-20-063 200 Route 6; various locations in Shank Painter Road, Browne Street, Commercial Street, Freeman Street

Notice of Intent filed by the Town of Provincetown, Dept. of Public Works, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for upgrades to Provincetown Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF), including construction of a peak flow storage tank, below-grade effluent pump station, and other WWTF upgrades; and sewer collection system upgrades in multiple locations in downtown Provincetown to provide connections for additional parcels. Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage, NHESP Estimated and Priority Habitat, and Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.
