Clipper Ventures represented by Ciara Dunne, new manager of the establishment. Mr. Dunne regrets the absence of Sara Cole; she is temporarily out of the country.
He stated that the violations were paid for. The windows that were to be replaced had some complications from the supplier yet will be completed next week. The second alleged violation was due to a sewage problem in the building thus causing the business to open the windows and doors to air out the establishment. Mr. Dunne also stated that the company is over-hauling the image and hoping to create a new more Irish setting for the bar.
The Licensing Board appreciates the interest, from Mr. Dunne, to fix the "problems" the bar has dealt with in the past however the majority of the board felt that little or lack of effort has been taken to by the company to expedite the corrections. They also were concerned that Sara Cole rarely represents the company and establishment at Licensing Board meetings. They reminded Mr. Dunne that she is the liable party for these violations occurring throughout the start of location in town. The manager representing the establishment should be the one whose name is on the licenses. Either Sara needs to be present or amending the manager's name on the license should take place.
