Goals and Objectives

- 1) The Licensing Board will continue to strengthen our service to the public with an increased emphasis on public safety.
- 2) The Licensing Board will continue to work on improving its communication and cooperation with other Boards.
- 3) The Licensing Board will continue to refine its Rules and Regulations and work on ways to educate the public regarding them.
- 4) The Licensing Board will continue to create new licenses as needed (e.g., temporary tattoo/outdoor artist) and eliminate licenses that are no longer appropriate (e.g., Float spaces after the Pier Corporation takes over Macmillan Pier 01/01/03) or those that are duplication with the Board of Health (e.g., Food Vendors and Soft Drink Vendors licenses). It is hoped to have licenses such as taxi Cabs and operators licenses, totally taken over by the Police Department.
- 5) The Licensing Board has a goal to meet with the Board of Selectman to discuss complex and sometimes controversial issues as live nudity and entertainment in hopes to assist in developing policies that all can support.
