

PROVINCETOWN CONSERVATION COMMISSION

**October 31, 2002 – Emergency Meeting
6:30 P.M.**

Members Present: Sheila Benzer, Roger Chauvette, Robin Evans, Peter Souza

Members Absent: Susan Avellar (unexcused)

Commissioner Robin Evans called the Meeting to order at 6:45 P.M.

The nature of the emergency was the November 1, 2002 deadline for submission to the State of bids/proposals regarding Parcels A and C through N along Route 6.

Public Comment: None.

Commission Discussion: The Commissioners discussed Peter Souza's 10-31-02 conversation with Town Manager Keith Bergman and the 10-31-02 memo from the Board of Selectmen to the Division of Capital Asset Management regarding the Town's proposal to acquire this land. It was pointed out that the Selectmen voted on whether there should be a conservation restriction on this land, and it was so voted, 4-1-0. The Commissioners discussed designating as conservation land the remainder of Parcel B (5.6 acres), that area not to be used for the Cape End Manor Care Campus.

Peter Souza moved that a letter be written to the Division of Capital Asset Management supporting the Selectmen's proposal to acquire Parcels A and C through N for direct public use for open space and conservation, and asking that the remaining 26.29 acres of Parcel B be designated as open space and conservation land. Roger Chauvette seconded it, and it was so voted 4-0-0.

Robin Evans moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 P.M., it was so voted unanimously.
