The Public Hearing convened at 7:00 p.m.

Larry Murphy opened the hearing by inviting David Guertin, DPW Director to give a brief presentation.

David Guertin issued out handouts explaining the proposed water rate. A letter from Mr. Anderson and

Mr MacIntyre objecting to the fees for fire sprinkler services was entered into the record.

Larry Murphy called for any public comments.

Barbara Rushmore presented a chart to the Board (attached to these minutes). She expressed her concern for the elderly and the poor. She feels they should be given a break.

Larry Murphy thanked Ms Rushmore for her comments and closed the public portion of the hearing.

Larry Murphy made a motion to eliminate the fire sprinkler fees from the proposed rate. Motion was seconded by David Perry. Motion passes 3/0.

Custodio Silva reviews the Water Department budget and notes it was passed by Finance Committee today.

Larry Murphy asks for the Board's recommendation and vote.

Custodio Silva makes a motion to approve the proposed water rate (see attached) without fire sprinkler fees. David Perry seconded. Vote passes 3/0.
