Issuance of Marriage Licenses in the Town of Provincetown

It shall be the policy of the Provincetown Board of Selectmen that the Town Clerk may issue marriage licenses to any persons-- whether residents of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, *non-Commonwealth residents that intend to reside in Massachusetts, or non-Commonwealth residents that do not intend to reside in Massachusetts--* who complete the *revised "Notice of Intention of Marriage"* form prescribed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and affirm the following statement thereon: *"I have reviewed a list of impediments to marriage for my place of residence and hereby state that there is an absence of any legal impediment to the marriage and do hereby depose and say that all of the statements as set forth in the above notice whereof could have knowledge are true and are made under the penalties of perjury (c.4, s.6, Rule 6 General Laws)."*

Town Counsel's opinions relative thereto shall be kept on file at the Office of the Town Clerk and made available for public inspection.
