HARBOR COMMITTEE

Noah Santos – Grew up here and lived on the water most of his life and the harbor is the most important part of his life. Interested in making harbor better than what it is. Not interested in Alternate Position.

PPPC BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Selectmen interviewed the following applicants for the Provincetown Public Pier Corporations Board of Directions position.

Marty Huey – Feels that there are reconciliation's that can be made and procedures that can be changed and that he will be able to make them. Allocation of responsibilities and assignments of the person sitting on the wharf ... marketing should not be the responsibility of the Harbormaster but the Board of Directors.

Candace Nagle - Float owner and also owner of Pier Gallery but does not feel that there is a conflict of interest. Maximize the pier for the best revenue possible for the town and have a lot of ideas to make this happen. She is away for the winter.

Kerry Adams – Grew up in Provincetown. Well aware of what is going on at the Pier and knowledge of the harbor. Current member of the Harbor Committee and will be willing to resign this position if appointed. Would like to purchase a boat to preserve the legacy of the Town – i.e., Provincetown's Fishing Industry, etc.
