The following are meeting minutes, in brief.

### **#1. Citizen Proposals:**

**Item G. We hereby request the Town to install a permanent handicap space in front of the Provincetown Art Association and Museum at 460 Commercial St. We have provided a handicap van space in our parking lot, but the need is for more accessible spaces. The handicap spaces near Kiley Court and the Schoolhouse do not serve PAAM as efficiently as a space on our block. (Requested by: PAAM Christine McCarty)**

**Item G. Board Action: *Move that the Board of Selectmen vote as requested by Christine McCarthy, at the discretion of the Traffic Team to be located on Commercial Street in the vicinity of the Art Association.***
