1 WATER UPDATE

Water Management Permitting and New Source Acquisition

David Guertin introduced the participants in tonight's presentation. Mark White gave a brief overview of where we left off after the last Workshop in June 2002 and the activities since then.

The purpose of this presentation is to provide a review of hydrogeologic modeling analyses (McLane & USGS) that supports conclusions on yield from Pilgrim and Pamet lens sources.

Charles McLane gave a Technical Presentation the following:

Lou Briganti spoke on the SCADA System improvements.
