### Review of ISO Audit

Two (2) Salvage cloths should be kept on each fire engine.

2 ½ inch straight stream nozzles should be carried on each fire engine. E190 had one. Combination nozzles were worth several points in the audit. Chief will fax info on the nozzles to the ISO inspector.

Fire Engine Pumps, Fire Hose, Ground Ladders and Arial Ladder are to be tested annually.

Inventory of all equipment shall be submitted to the board annually by the Captains. Captains will be advised by letter.

### Vaughn Cabral

Letter received from Vaughn asking to be reinstated as a member of the PFD. Letter will be sent to Cabral dismissing him from the PFD.

**Motion:** Alexander motioned to dismiss Cabral from the PFD; Menangas seconded the motion for discussion;
