Public Statements

Barbara Rushmore congratulated the committee on the Bas-relief project. She expressed concern that the Beautification Committee become involved in the regreening of the Leaching Areas for the new sewer system.

She was very concerned about the large electric substation on the new pier next to the Waterfront Park. John Dowd also spoke to congratulate us on the Bas-relief project.

Old Business

The Pilgrim Monument and Museum Board meeting will be held on May 21 to discuss the encroachment on their land during the Bas-relief reconstruction. James will attend.

Information on plaque for Lopes Square Anchor delayed until next meeting.

Discussion on regreening of Leaching Areas for new sewer system delayed until next meeting.

New Business

James moved he be reimbursed for planting costs for barrels at Lopes Square and Post Office in amounts of \$57.63 and \$435.00. Approved unanimously.

James moved that Robin Evans be reimbursed for cost of fertilizer for trees in the amount of \$30.096 and \$28.56. Approved unanimously.

James moved that Barbara Rushmore be reimbursed \$308.00 from the gift fund for the Beech tree planted at High Pole Hill and Bradford. Approved unanimously.

James moved the remainder of the operating budget for FY2002 go toward plantings and construction expenses at the Bas-relief. Approved unanimously.
