New Seasonal All Alcohol Restaurant License

1. Petition for a ***Seasonal All Alcohol Restaurant License*** from Krista Kranyak, representing ***Ten Tables Restaurant & Bar Provincetown***, 133 Bradford St., Provincetown, MA. Krista Kranyak currently operates two restaurants in Boston – Jamaica Plain and Cambridge and has won Best of Boston four times in a row. Seven letters in favor. No one opposed.

Revision to the Licensing Board Rules & Regulations

1. Input from the public regarding the potential amendment to the Provincetown Licensing Regulation Section 3.00 Alcoholic Beverages Licenses, as described below:

3.00 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES

3.01 General Provisions

No change to Section a) or b)

c) The hours of alcohol sales allowed at businesses licensed with pouring licenses are between 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. weekdays and between ~~noon~~ 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. on Sundays, the last Monday in May and on Christmas Day or on the day following when said day occurs on Sunday, and shall be specified as the closing time stated in the license. The Licensing Board will vote to extend pouring licenses until 2:00 a.m. on New Year's Eve at the final meeting in November. Licensees do not need to attend meeting unless they are requested by the Licensing Board and will not be contacted unless permission is not being granted due to numerous violations.

No further changes to this Section.

Discussion – David Gardner reminds the Licensing Board that this amendment to the Licensing Board Rules & Regulations comes from the Article that was passed at Special Town Meeting. Mr. Gardner suggests that the Licensing Board take action on amending existing 2011 licenses that have already been issued by a vote to authorize licensees who have already been issued their license to start serving alcohol at 10 a.m. on Sundays. The Licensing Agent will send a letter to those licensees from the Town Manager's Office to that effect.
