Two requests were made. One for hose and pump for the Building and Grounds Watering Truck. The next was for stabilization of the bench in front of the Old Library. These requests will be taken up at a later date. Todd Westrick suggested that tree pruning might cost thousands.

Todd Westrick had a packet for each committee member of the six traffic islands with photographs, locations, inventory, shrubbery, signage, receptacles and recommendations. An enthusiastic discussion ensued.

Fishermen's Memorial: Carol Peters, Kerry Adams and Silvia Newman met with Paul Hall, Todd Westrick and Mary Ann Powers. The Fishermen's Memorial Committee have a 5 year plan.
