

Public Notice

2011 Annual Spring Traffic Hearing Results

The Provincetown Board of Selectmen held a public hearing on **Tuesday, March 15, 2011 at 6 p.m.** in the Judge Welsh Hearing Room, Town Hall 260 Commercial St., Provincetown, Massachusetts 02657 and then and there approved the following proposals:

1. Citizen Proposals

- a. Move 'Unloading Zone' sign at 430 Commercial St. 5 feet toward the West End of Town.
- b. Add 4 new taxi stands, allow the expansion of 1, and require all newly approved spaces to return to next year's traffic hearing.
 - 1 taxi stand in front of the Tourism Office
 - 1 taxi stand Corner of Standish St. and Commercial St. next to the Governor Bradford facing Bradford St. and 1 at Lopes Square
 - 1 taxi stand West End between Carver St. and Atlantic St.
 - Expand Masonic Place to allow 2 taxis instead of 1 after 4 PM
- c. Require all property owners on Railroad Avenue between Conwell Street and Upper Center Street to cut back the bushes and remove fences and other obstructions on the public right-of-way, and to comply with this decision within 30 days of publication of this notice.
- d. Prohibit parking along Commercial St. from Pointe St. to the Ptown Inn when the National Weather Service issues a forecast for a hurricane (winds over 74 mph).
- f. Move one parking spot at 2 Aunt Sukeys Way 3 – 4 feet to the north. If this is not amenable to all parties, then remove the space.
- g. Remove one parking space at the corner of Brown and Pleasant streets.
- h. Make Brewster St. north of Bradford 'Resident Only' parking.
- q. Reduce the speed limit on Conwell St. from 30 mph to 25 mph from Rt. 6 to Harry Kemp Way, and to 20 mph from Harry Kemp Way to Bradford Street.
- r. Remove the last parking space on Center St. nearest to the corner of Railroad Avenue.
- s. Install a three-way 'Stop Sign' where Harry Kemp Way meets Howland St.

2. **Chief of Police Proposals:** Request the Cape Cod Commission to conduct a traffic safety study of the intersection of Rt. 6 and Conwell St.
3. **Parking Department Proposals:** Proposal by the Provincetown Parking Department:
 - a. Increase Parking Permits effective April 1, 2011:
 - Resident Permit from \$50 to \$55
 - Commercial Resident from \$135 to \$140
 - Non Resident Property Owner from \$90 to \$100
 - Non Resident from \$250 to \$275
 - Non Resident Grace Hall Only from \$175 to \$200
 - Increase Arts Dune Tours from \$900 to \$1,000
 - Trolley tours from \$900 to \$1,000
 - Jerome Smith only car weekly (7 days) from \$35 to \$40
 - Jerome Smith only Camper Resident from \$135 to \$150
 - Jerome Smith only Camper Non-resident from \$400 to \$425
 - b. Create a weekly (7days) Grace Hall Only permit for Guests of Guesthouses with no parking for \$75.
 - c. Increase parking meter enforcement from 12 hours daily to 16 hours daily (8:00 AM to midnight).
 - d. Change Alden St. closest to Bradford St. (diagonal spaces) from "Residents Only 3 hours max" to pay spaces with no time limit.
 - e. Remove a parking space at 26 Bradford St. and repaint lines to give equal space on both sides of the property.
