of The Provincetown Licensing Board Public Meeting on **Tuesday, March 8, 2011** at 5:15 p.m. in the Judge Welsh Meeting Room, Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street.

## ***Public Hearings***

### **New Seasonal Wine & Malt Restaurant License – Continued from February 22, 2011**

1. Petition for a ***Seasonal Wine & Malt Restaurant License*** from Julie Knapp, representing ***Twist'd Sister***, 293 Commercial St., Provincetown, MA.

Julie Knapp hands out detailed plans for beer and wine service and a list of goals. Ms. Knapp has obtained TIPS Certification. Service of beer and wine will end at 11:00 p.m. AJ Petras suggest placing a “no alcohol beyond this point” sign in an area after the ice cream counter.

**Motion to approve with the restrictions that service of beer and wine end at 11:00 p.m., there is proper signage throughout the establishment, and the front window seats are excluded from the area of service during the peak season by AJ Petras. Seconded by George Young. Approved 3-0.**

### **Special Entertainment License**

1. Petition from Gina Longo, representing ***Outer Cape Health Services, Inc.*** for a **Special Entertainment License** for an event to be held on Sunday, April 3, 2011 from 1 PM until 4 PM at 49 Harry Kemp Way, Provincetown, MA. No rain date requested.

Kristin Young representing Outer Cape Health Services, Inc. – the event will be a ribbon cutting ceremony to commemorate the opening of the Health Center. There will be speakers and music.
