Special Entertainment/Special Liquor License

Petition from Robbie Samuels, representing ***Gay & Lesbian Advocates & Defenders*** for a ***Special Entertainment and Special Liquor License*** for an event to be held July 30, 2011 from 4 pm until 7 pm at Pilgrim Monument & Provincetown Museum, 1 High Pole Hill Rd. No rain date requested. Kevin Soyt, representing GLAD, 30th Summer Event, running from 4 -7pm. Admission for the event. Kristin Hatch asked for clarity about security and volunteers. Christopher Snow provided additional information; stating no incidents have occurred in years past. There will be three bars with four additional stations. All alcohol is confined within the area. No amplified music. Kristin Hatch requests the applicant include additional information next year including, attendance numbers, catering information, security, alcohol control, event layout, and other information to help understand the event.
