Cape Cod National Seashore General Management Plan Implementation Advisory Committee (CCNSGMPIAC)

Wednesday, May 5, 2010

Meeting called to order at 5.30pm.

The Committee agreed to forward a draft letter to the Board of Selectmen for their consideration regarding a preliminary determination of exclusion of one of the dune shacks (the Chanel Shack) in the final listing on the National Register of Historic Places for the Peaked Hill Bars Historic District.

The Committee agreed to forward a request to the Board of Selectmen for a joint public meeting in order to maintain good communication between the Board and the Committee to best serve the Town regarding its ongoing relationships with Cape Cod National Seashore and the National Park Service.

The Committee discussed concerns about CCNS's lack of continued commitment to the upkeep of the parking area to the right of the Herring Cove Beach (formerly "New Beach") entrance area.

The Committee discussed concerns about CCNS's Moors Road project, specifically whether it has planned sufficiently to adequately address the restoration of the salt pond near the Bradford Street intersection by including adequate water flow and other rehabilitative efforts.

A member of the public, Irene Briga, spoke in favor of continued public access to the Peaked Hill Bars Dune Shack District in a manner similar to the current situation and varied arrangements involving the public, families and dune shack residents, and non-profit organizational use.

The next Committee meeting was set for Wednesday, May 26, 2010 at 5.30pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 6.20pm.
