



## Public Workshop Notice

### Shank Painter Road & Route 6 Rehabilitation Project

The Town of Provincetown continues to work on a project to plan, design and construct roadway improvements along Shank Painter Road and Route 6 that will improve vehicular access and pedestrian and bicycle accommodations. A Public Workshop will be held to accommodate one-on-one discussions between the public, abutters, and representatives from the Provincetown Department of Public Works and Environmental Partners Group, Inc. This open-house will include revisiting previously considered alternatives to explain each, to solicit further public input, to gain an understanding for supported or unsupported treatments, and to address any questions or concerns. *Attendance is strongly encouraged to articulate concerns or support for each alternative and/or any site-specific concerns so the input can be taken into consideration as the design advances.*

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the meeting is to provide the public with another opportunity to become fully acquainted with the alternatives of the proposed project and to solicit input for consideration as design plans advance. The previously discussed alternatives will be on hand along with the pro's and con's of each. Comments received at past public outreach will be discussed along with subsequent alterations made around existing site constraints. The public is encouraged to discuss their concerns of existing conditions within the project limits to recommend adjustments and features. The input will be used to refine the design and to select components or features that will be included in the advanced design. Future meetings will take place throughout the design process to continue public involvement as components of the project are further detailed.

**PROPOSAL:** The proposed project is anticipated to include improvements to traffic circulation and safety, and pedestrian and bicycle facilities along Shank Painter Road from the intersection of Bradford Street to the intersection of Route 6 for an approximate length of 2,900 feet. It will also include a 1.1 mile segment of Route 6 to link pedestrian and bicycle accommodations from Shank Painter Road to Herring Cove Beach and the National Seashore.
