Dear Neighbor,

As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers and communities, we are preparing to begin construction of an Energy Storage System in Provincetown. This project is a 24.9-megawatt battery storage system designed to enhance the reliability of the electric distribution system on the Outer Cape.

We're Always Working to Serve You Better

Beginning March 2020, Eversource and their contractor, Lawrence Lynch Construction, Co., will begin construction to install a new battery storage system located at the Provincetown Transfer Station. Construction activities include site preparation, such as tree clearing and grading the site; building construction to house the battery system and installing underground utilities along the roadside and Transfer Station driveway.

What You Can Expect

Since your property is on or near the Project site, here is important information about how we will work in your neighborhood:

- **Reliable Service:** Be assured that this work will not interrupt electric service to your property.
- **Proper Identification:** All people working on this project carry identification. Eversource personnel will occasionally be in your neighborhood to tell you what to expect with the nearby construction project. They may leave an informational doorhanger at your home or knock on your door to talk to you about the project work. We're letting you know about this outreach in advance, so you can be confident that the outreach is being conducted by a legitimate Eversource representative and is not a scam.
- **Where We'll Be Working:** Within the Provincetown Transfer Station, along a portion of Route 6 and Race Point Road.
- **Communication:** Keeping the lines of communication open is important to us. Field outreach representatives will provide updates to keep you informed of our work. In the meantime, feel free to reach out to us by email at ProjectInfo@eversource.com or call 1-800-793-2202 if you have any questions.
- **Construction Schedule:** Construction will be Monday through Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. If longer work hours are needed, we will request permission from the Town of Provincetown. Please keep in mind that the schedule also may change due to weather and other unexpected circumstances.
- **Construction Activities:**
 - > **IN THE COMING WEEKS:** Over the next two weeks, Eversource contractors will conduct preliminary fieldwork activities such as soil borings and survey work on Race Point Road and within the Provincetown Transfer Station. Access to the Transfer Station during regular business hours will always be available.
 - > **OVERALL,** you can expect:
 - Tree clearing, site grading and the construction of a building at the Provincetown Transfer Station
 - Excavation and trenching along the driveway to the Transfer Station, Race Point Road, and Route 6 to remove sections of existing road surfaces

- Installing conduit housing electric cable in a new underground duct bank
 - Temporary restoration of roadways and other areas disturbed by construction work
- > **PROJECT COMPLETION:** We expect to complete the overall project and conduct final restoration of disturbed areas by December 2020. Schedule is subject to change.
