VOTING INFORMATION

TIME & PLACE: Monday, April 4th, 2022 @ 6PM Town Meeting at 260 Commercial St

YES VOTE:

- Secures \$1.8M in funding assistance from the Town of Provincetown.
- Will send project funding to the annual town election for final approval, May 10th.
- Construction could begin in Summer of 2023 with completion in Fall 2024 or Spring of 2025.
- It will cost taxpayers \$3.37-\$4.75 per \$100,000 assessed value for the next 15 years.

NO VOTE:

- Does NOT secure \$1.8M in funding assistance from the Town of Provincetown.
- Project will remain unfunded, and all progress will be halted until funding can become available.
- No public restrooms.
- Does not address failing seawall.
- Accessibility to all remains limited.

PROJECT BACKGROUND



WHY THIS PROJECT?

Creating a new park in this location will address several factors impacting the current site including:

- Accessibility challenges
- Coastal flooding
- Urban Heat Island Effect
- No shaded areas
- Safety site concerns
- No restrooms

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Creates a waterfront park that meets the year-round needs of residents and visitors for passive recreation opportunities. Defined by completed robust community planning process.
- Creates direct ADA access between the waterfront park and the adjacent harbor beach.
- Protects and enhances the waterfront's sensitive natural resources and wildlife habitat.
- Incorporates interpretive elements that creatively inform the public about this parcel's importance to Provincetown's historic fishing industry and the harbor's unique ecosystem.
