Pursuant to Provincetown Parking Regulations, Ch. 6, Section 6-5-1, the Parking Department shall refuse to issue a permit, or revoke an assigned permit, without any refund of fees paid, for any vehicle, person or business with past due Provincetown

financial obligations including taxes, water and sewer charges and parking violations.
