**FY 2014 CPA Funding Cycle:** Chair of Rec. Commission Treg Kaeselau and Recreation Director Brandon Motta present to discuss changes in Recreation component of CPA funding. General discussion with members about process, due date [Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> ], eligibility of rehabilitation and capital improvements to existing recreation facilities as well as to regional facilities. Recreation representatives indicated that they may submit an application for the rehabilitation of the East-end basketball court which is in dire need of work. It is a popular spot. Discussion about the need for scope or work and budget with attached estimates and letters of support as part of the application. Other basketball courts need work as well. There is an issue with the sand in the playground – something from the underlying soil rises up and mixes in, need for analysis. Motta Field is now under the direction of the Recreation Department and could be future application. They were encouraged to bring any potential projects to future meetings for discussion.
