

CHARTER ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION

1. David Gardner, Acting Town Manager, asked for approval by the CEC on his determination to allow 3 additional months to new DPW head, Richard Waldo on his efforts to obtain a residence in Provincetown, since Charter only allows 3 months. The Chair informed him that the CEC had no authority to approve, only authority to investigate a complaint by a resident. Since no complaint has been filed to date, the matter is left as it stands. Julia Perry informed Mr. Gardner that the CRAH is considering this matter and shared the current draft rewrite of Chapter 8, including a waiver provision for the residency requirement. Mr. Gardner asked that the CRAH also consider changing the time period by which residency must be acquired from 3 months to 6 months.
2. Chair, Tina Trudel, formally announced her retirement. Commission elected Julia Perry as the new Chair and Lisa Westervelt to replace Julia as Secretary.
3. The Draft Adjudicatory Hearing Guide was adopted by the Commission as amended. The Chair advised that she would forward it to the Town Clerk for implementation.
