Minutes of the Provincetown Shellfish Advisory Committee October 14, 2014 Meeting

Meeting called to order at 5:04 PM.

Members present: Lory Santos, chair; Mel Cote, Nancy Ann Meads. Also Present: David Flattery and Shellfish Constable, Tonny Jackett.

The minutes of September 9, 2014 postponed as sufficient members present at that meeting were not present.

Old Business: Shellfish constable reported that water and clam samples have been submitted to the State and if all is well, the shellfish season will open on November 7th on the West side of the breakwater in the West end.

New Business: The constable reported that he had accepted a position as warden in the town of Truro. A discussion was held concerning the possibility of continuing Mr. Jackett as shellfish constable on a part time basis. Mel Cote made a motion that we ask the Board of Selectmen to appoint Mr. Jackett on a part time basis for the Town of Provincetown. The motion was seconded by Nancy Ann Meads and the vote was four to zero to forward the request to the Board of Selectmen. It was deemed important that we be able to retain the services and expertise of Mr. Jackett. There may be a possibility to have a second part time person if the job becomes more difficult with the advent of the ADA program.

- 1. Nancy Ann Meads made a motion to nominate David Flattery as a full member of the Shellfish Advisory Committee. The vote was three in favor and none opposed. Mr. Flattery was called in to the meeting and told that he could report to the town clerk to take the oath of office.
- 2. The meeting was voted closed at 5:30. The next meeting will be held November 4th.
