- A) Application to join the Recreation Commission from Lori Arnott as an Alternate Position- Elisabeth makes a motion to approve Lori Arnott's application. David seconds that motion. Motion approved.

- A) Continued discussion on a possible project for the FY 16 CPA grant round- Brandon mentions that the current scoreboard on Motta Field is in rough shape and needs to be removed or replaced. Elisabeth asks how often the scoreboard gets used and suggests it be taken down or replaced with a regular sign. Treg suggests applying for the resurfacing of the East End Playground and possibly for the shade for the VMCC Playground.

Directors Report:

- A) Halloween Greet n' Treat –The Greet n' Treat was very successful and that next year looks like it will be even larger. There are about 20 Provincetown businesses and organizations that participated in the event and about 150 children.
- B) VMCC roof update – The roof has been replaced on one wing of the building which has completed fixed all leaks for that area. The other wing and the gymnasium need to be replaced next as they are still leaking.

Assistant Directors Report:

- A) Clothing Swap – The 2nd Annual Clothing Swap was very successful. There were more people than last year and several people have asked if there will be one in the spring as well. We will hopefully be able to do the clothing swaps two times a year.
- B) Battle of the Badges – The 2nd Annual Battle of the Badges game will be on December 20th. The Provincetown PD and Provincetown FD will be competing as part of a fundraiser for new basketball uniforms for the kids. The winner will receive the plaque to keep in their station for the year.
