The meeting was called to order by Chair Bill Dougal at 7:00 P.M.

Those present were Chairman Bill Dougal, Jennifer Bedard, Gail Enos, Sue Buerkel, Alice Foley, Irene Rabinowitz, Gordon Siegel and Rick Holland and Robert Vetrick. Ruth Gilbert was excused.

- I. Chair Bill Dougal called the meeting because some members expressed concern about the Finance Committee's recommendation for STM-11. (Library move to Heritage Museum) Gordon Siegel made a motion to reconsider STM-11, Jennifer Bedard seconded and it passed unanimously.

Discussion about the ramifications of approving this article ensued and some members expressed that they felt that the Finance Committee should take a stronger stand on this issue. After discussion, Robert Vetrick made a motion to reverse the previous vote and not recommend this article. Alice Foley seconded and a 7-2-0 vote was taken to not recommend this article.
