

Meeting of the Board of Fire Engineers

June 7, 2000

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Meeting called to order at 8:15 p.m.

Raising of Station #5 (514 Commercial St.) discussed.

One bid received from Winkler Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$102,980.00.

Board in agreement to re-advertise the Raising of Station #5.

Motion: Notaro made a motion to re-advertise the specifications for the Raising of Station #5; Wolf seconded the motion; All in favor.

New Rescue Vehicle 196 discussed.

One (1) bid received from Bert's Emergency Vehicles in the amount of \$99,475.00.

Motion: Notaro made a motion to make a recommendation to the Town Manager to accept the bid received from Bert's Emergency Vehicles; Roderick seconded the motion; All in favor.

Motion: Alexander made a motion to install a plaque in the new rescue vehicle with the names of the board members; Wolf seconded the motion; Six in favor-One opposed. Motion passed.

New Fire Engine 195 discussed.

Chief Trovato stated that Emergency Vehicles of Maine (Ferrara) was the bidder who came the closest to meeting the specs. Ferrara's bid was in the amount of \$189,895.

Central States checked yes to everything but then wrote their own specs. Dingee presented their bid without the bid bond and there were many variations in the specs.

Motion: Alexander made a motion to accept Emergency Vehicles of Maine (Ferrara) bid and so notify the Town Manager; Wolf seconded the motion; All in favor.
