Request for Administrative Review and Approval by Bruce Deely on behalf of Mimi Gross pursuant to the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, reconstruct an existing deck without enlarging but adding concrete piers for support. Work to take place within NHESP Estimated and Priority Habitat.

Request for Determination of Applicability by Safe Harbor Environmental Services on behalf of Weibe Tinga pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s.40) and Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetland Protection Bylaw for the planting of native vegetation. Work to take place within the Buffer Zone to a Coastal Dune.

Notice of Intent by Bennett Environmental Associates, Inc. on behalf of Thomas Boland and Jim Farley pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s.40) and Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, to demolish the existing dwelling and construct a new dwelling within the existing footprint, upgrade the septic system and associated sitework and grading.
