Chief's Report

Barnstable County Course Aircraft Familiarization Safety and Egress was held on April 9, 2017. The ARFF vehicle was included in the course for a vehicle check, operations overview, and airfield review. This is part of the First Responder course. The instructor was Norman J. Aubert Jr.

Aubert advised the Chief that he was concerned about the nozzle on the hand wheel of the ARFF vehicle. It should be rated at 85 gals per minute and is adjustable. His concern was that if it gets changed, we will use our chemical and our water faster. He suggested we call Rosenbauer to find out why they installed an adjustable nozzle. Aubert suggested a fixed 85 gal per minute nozzle.

Ladder 192 was taken to Specialty Vehicles for adjustments. Parts were ordered and LED lights.

Donation of \$2,000 received from the Northeast Ursamen. Check will be given to the Firemen's Association Fund.

Minutes of February 15, 2017 reviewed.

New windows and trim are ready to be installed on Station 5, located at 514 Commercial St. Tony Lemme is working on the project.

Main Station Oil Furnace needs to be replaced. The Chief will speak to someone at DPW.

Air Officer E.J. Martinez will be advised to contact Fire Tech & Safety. The Caps for the Air Bottles to cover the threads, the Air Bags, Cribbons, Straps and the Air Masks were ordered some time ago. Deputy Roderick will be asked to discuss the needs with Martinez.

The Chief was not sure if Chuck LaCross had been contacted to complete the repairs needed to L192, E193 & E194. The Chief will speak to Deputy Roderick regarding the repairs.
