The Provincetown Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing at 6:30 p.m. on **Tuesday, June 6, 2017** in the Judge Welsh Room, Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA to consider the following requests:

CON-17-163 74R and 76R Bayberry Avenue

Notice of Intent filed by Coastal Acres Properties, LLC, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s.40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for a seasonal leaf collection management plan for the campground area. Work to take place within NHESP Estimated and Priority Habitat, Bordering Land Subject to Flooding, and the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetland.

CON-17-164 15 Commercial Street

Request for Determination of Applicability filed by the VRI Condominium Association, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s.40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for the in-kind replacement of beach access stairs within an easement on the property at 15 Commercial Street for the benefit of the condominium unit owners at 12 Commercial Street. Work to take place within Coastal Beach and Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage.

CON-17-165 Provincetown Harbor – 2017 Batch Aquaculture Permitting

Notice of Intent filed by the Town of Provincetown Shellfish Department, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s.40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for the batch permitting of aquaculture grants within 8.79 acres of land under Provincetown Harbor located in the area east of the West End Breakwater, within NHESP Estimated and Priority Habitat, Land Under the Ocean and Land Containing Shellfish.
