

Minutes of the June 14, 2017 Recycling & Renewable Energy Committee Meeting

Meeting called to order [at 9:30](#)

-Discussed committee finances - Jay will be meeting with Mark Hatch of Finance Committee to discuss additional funding for RREC to purchase more water bottle refilling stations.

-Jay reported back on meeting with Bike Committee -- recommends partnering with other committees, such as the Health board and Bike Committee

Lydia talked to town plumber - narrowed choices of water bottle refilling stations down to 3 or so - much choose and purchase before the end of the month

Lydia and Jay reported back on Outer Cape Energy Committee meeting in Wellfleet, a new group that is organising an Outer Cape version of Solarize Mass, a pilot project focusing on two energy sources: photovoltaic and battery backup

Committee voted in favor of joining the Outer Cape Energy Committee

Committee voted in favor of asking the Board of Selectman to agree to participate in Outer Cape Energy Committee Solarize Mass pilot project

Lydia reported back on meeting with the school

- Need to get a recycling bin for the playground

Tim Famulare, the town Conservation Agent, came to the meeting and will be the staff liaison. discussed the B-Street garden compost, concerns over management of the compost plot.

Committee discussed possibility of a collaborative sub-committee to oversee the management of the compost in the future

Recycling bins - discussed increasing number in town, replacing old trash bins with dual-use recycling/trash bins and repurposing old bins

Provincetown Int'l Film Fest and Movie.Mind.Green, environmental consulting agency, will be organizing popcorn composting this week during the festival with members of the committee who volunteered to pick up and host the popcorn in their compost pile
