### CON-18-036 **1 Bayberry Avenue**

Request for Determination of Applicability filed by Janet Bustrin, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for the removal of pine and oak trees. Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage and Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetland.

### CON-18-037 **561 Commercial Street**

Request for Determination of Applicability filed by River Hawk Environmental, LLC, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for the remediation of a release of fuel oil, to include soil removal and off-site recycling, abandonment of former septic tank, installation/operation of soil vapor extraction system, and site restoration work. Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage and Buffer Zone to Coastal Beach.
