

RREC DEC. 20, 2017

Meeting called to order 9am

Elise, Lydia, Jen, Tess and Sherry present.

Lydia moves to approve minutes from 11/8; Elise seconded. All in favor.

Budget—Sherry: Panagore was unable to look at it. Not denied or approved. David Gardener wasn't able to be present. We are on the consent agenda with the BOS on January 2nd. If it gets pulled Sherry will be there to explain why we need more money.

Compost Program—Sherry: all about space and logistics. We have a couple low haulers to take stuff to Dennis. Another vehicle on Water Dept. with a lift gate. Grant can pay for a lift gate on a truck for compost. Possibility of having access to two trailers as well.

Tess: Impressed by attendance. People from Wellfleet, Eastham...

Watts farm (Ajay) was very interested in it and will work with taking compost. Our RDP points went from 6 to 13 and upped the amount we get from \$3600 to \$7800

Signage might be an added cost, but we have money in our budget for that.

OCEC—Jay: RFP has been released and we're waiting. Installers are all backed up. (Blue Cell is telling independent buyers they will not be doing any installations by the end of March.)
