CON-19-006 106 Bradford Street (Bas Relief Park)

Notice of Intent filed by Ray Dunetz Landscape Architecture on behalf of the Town of Provincetown, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for landscaping and site improvements, including Bas Relief restoration. Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage.

CON-19-007 381-383 Commercial Street

Notice of Intent filed by Bull Ring Wharf Condominium Association, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for proposed pile addition for structural support of building and deck. Work to take place within Coastal Beach and Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage.

CON-19-008 90 Race Point Road (Transfer Station)

Local Bylaw Filing Application filed by Eversource Energy, pursuant to the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, to conduct subsurface environmental and geotechnical investigation borings. Work to take place within NHESP Estimated and Priority Habitat.
